2.0 Paramilitary Training Requirements:

Due to the paramilitary nature of training, applicants must have:

- 1) Physical and mental fitness as follow:
 - i). No history of accident or serious ailment (disease)
 - ii). Ability to pass an entrance paramilitary medical examination
 - iii). No mental or physical disability
 - iv). No tattoos on any part of the body
 - v). Not pregnant or breastfeeding (for female applicants)
- 2) Age between 18 to 24 years old (for unemployed applicants)
- 3) No record of criminal activity.
- 4) High discipline.

3.0 Fees Coverage:

The respective fees shown in table 1 for the courses cater for tuition, field practical training, accommodation, meals, uniform, first aid and NACTE quality assurance.

4.0 Mode of Application:

- i) Qualified applicants should apply for admission directly to the Institute from 27th May 2021.

- vi) Applicants with foreign secondary school certificates must attach equivalent results from National Examinations Council of Tanzania (NECTA). *Incomplete applications shall not be processed.*
