History

Caravan Serai slave trade museum is a place which have history of slave trade and ivory back in 19th century, among the existing remains are old buldings of 1860's well, mark of the pillars, Abushiri's wall of 1888 e.t.c during colonization period of Arabs, Germany and British in the coast of East Africa.

Caravan Serai was the special area where the slaves reach through the central route of slavery before transported to Zanzibar which was a big slave market in East Africa, however this is area where the name 'BAGAMOYO' was born as when the slave arrieved they were told by slaves masters 'Bwagamoyo' meaning lay down the burden of your heart there is no hope of return back home. Caravan Serai was the starting point of the slaves traders to the interior to collect slaves and ivory and the end of walking journey of slaves before transported to Zanzibar.
