- Maintain a safe distance from all animals.
- Never feed wildlife, as it can harm their health and alter natural behaviors.
- Use binoculars and a camera with a zoom lens to observe animals without disturbing them.

Leave No Trace

- Carry out all trash and dispose of waste properly (TRASH IN/TRASH OUT).
- Stick to marked trails to minimize environmental impact.
- Avoid picking plants or disturbing natural features.

Safety First

- Inform someone about your travel plans and expected return time.
- Carry a first-aid kit and know basic first aid.
- Be aware of park alerts and follow ranger recommendations.

Stay Informed

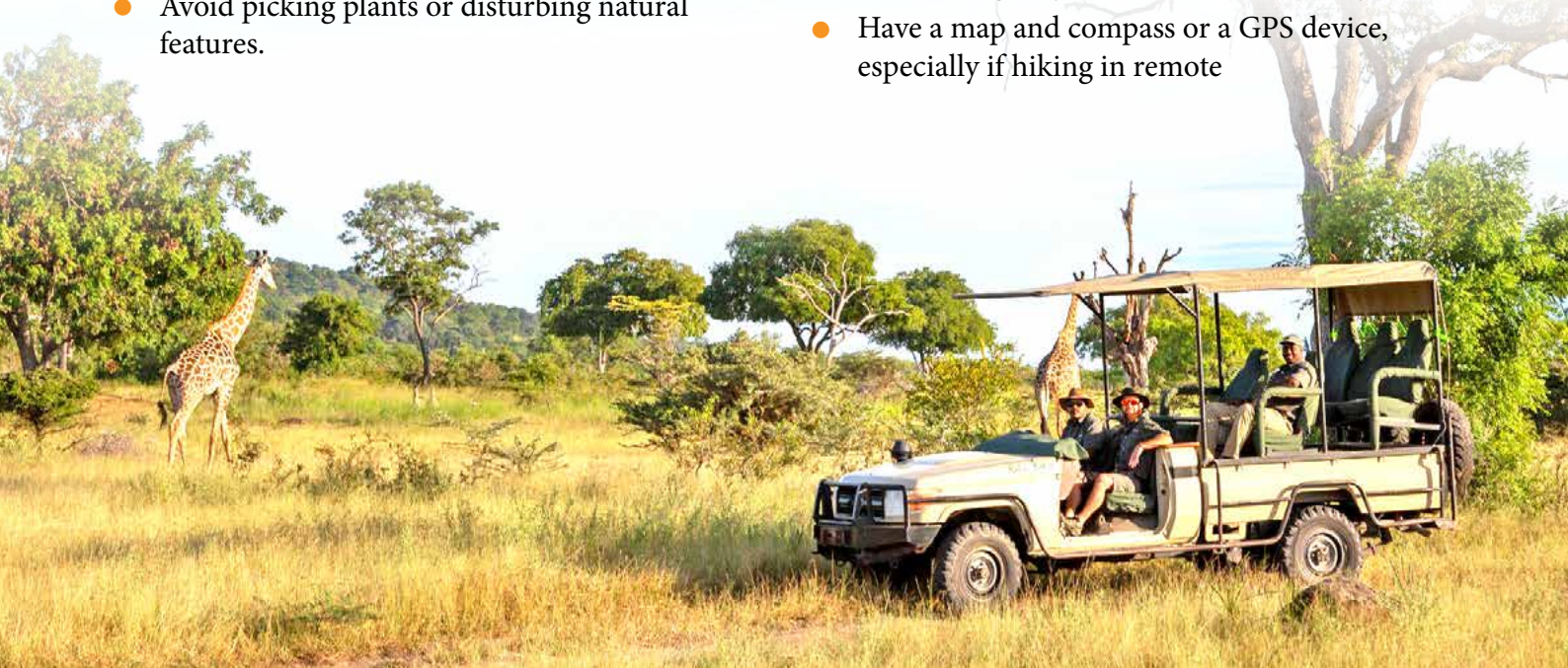
- Attend ranger-led programs or talks to learn about the park's ecology and history.
- Visit the park's visitor center for maps, information, and advice from park staff.

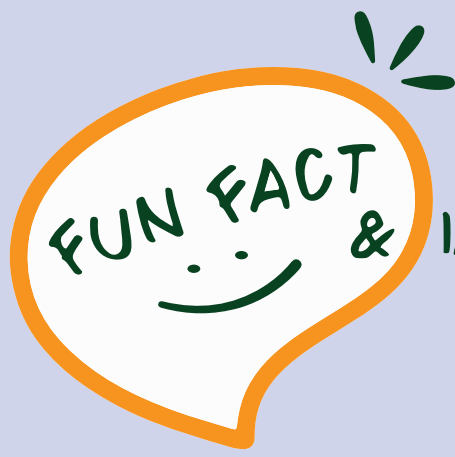
Photography Tips

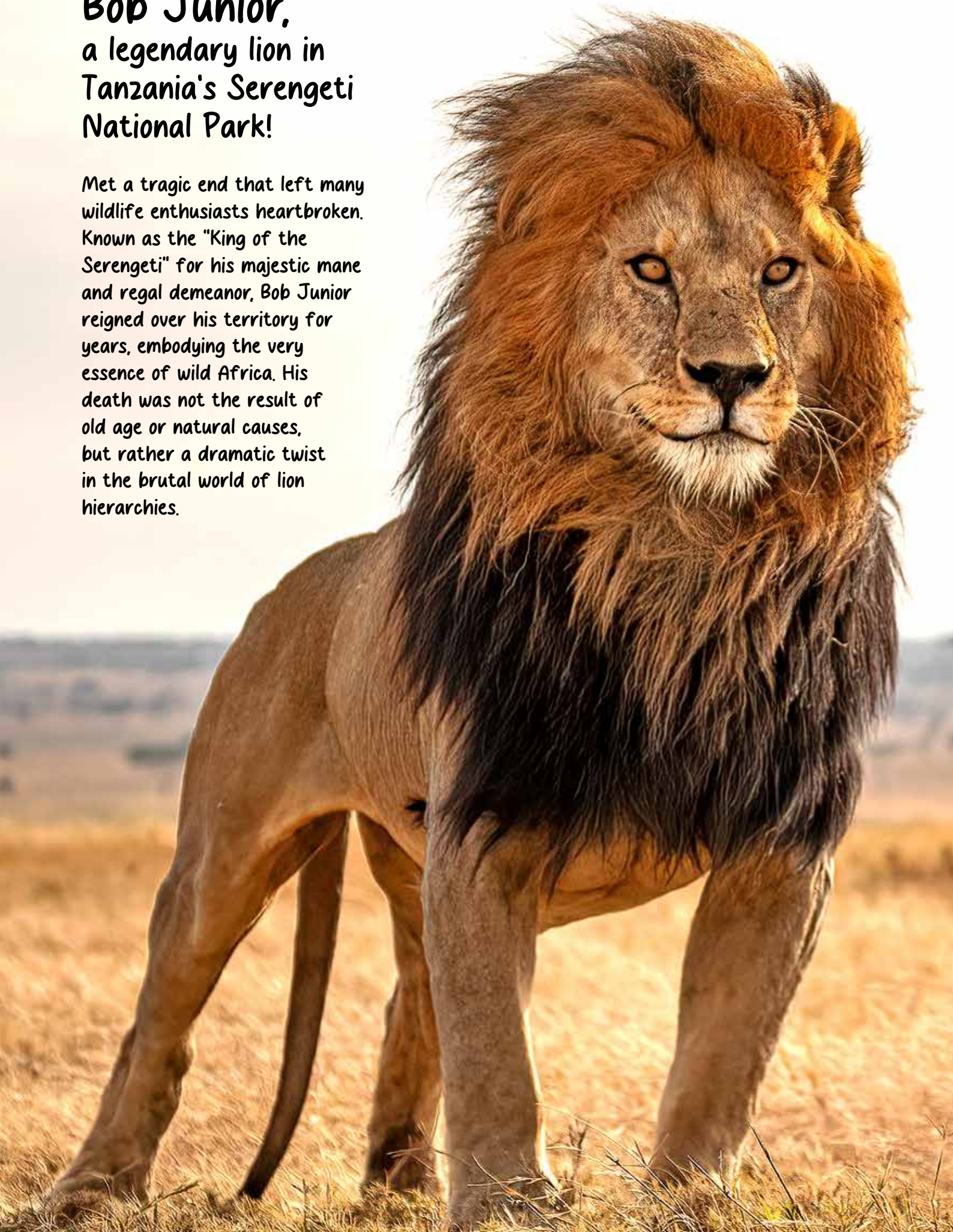
