1. This invitation for tender follows the General Procurement Notice for this project that appeared in United Nations Development Business (UNDB) Issue No. OP00057061 of 17th August 2018.
2. The Government of the United Republic of Tanzania has received a credit from the World Bank towards the cost of the RESILIENT NATURAL RESOURCES MANAGEMENT FOR TOURISM AND GROWTH (REGROW) project and intends to apply part of the proceeds to cover eligible payments under the works contracts for **Construction and Upgrading of Airstrips in Mikumi, Nyerere, and Ruaha National Parks - Package A: Lot 1- Kikoboga Airstrip in Mikumi National Park and Lot 2- Kibambawe and Mtemere Airstrips in Nyerere National Park**
3. The Trustees of Tanzania National Parks now invites sealed bids from eligible bidders for

4. Bidders have the option to Bid for any one or more lots. Bids will be evaluated lot-wise. The contract(s) will be awarded to the Bidder or Bidders offering the lowest evaluated cost to the Employer for each lot, subject to the selected Bidder(s) meeting the required qualification criteria for a respective lot or combination of lots as the case may be.
5. Qualifications requirements for the works include: (i) experience as prime contractor in construction of at least one (1) work similar nature and complexity in the last Five years with value of **USD 4 million for Lot 1 and USD 7 million for Lot 2** or its equivalent per lot; (ii) Average Annual Turnover calculated as total certified payments received for contracts in progress

or completed, within the last five (5) years of **USD 8 million for Lot 1 and USD 14 Million for Lot 2** or its equivalent per lot (iii) minimum amount of liquid assets and/or credit facilities net of other contractual commitments of **USD 1.2 million for Lot 1 and 2.5 million for Lot 2** or its equivalent per lot. Procurement of the Works under this bid Package A: (**Lot 1: Construction and Upgrading of Kikoboga Airstrip in Mikumi National Park and Lot 2: Construction and Upgrading of Mtemere and Kibambawe Airstrips in Nyerere National Park**) is being advertised and will be executed concurrently with other **Package B: Construction and Upgrading of three (3) Airstrips (Ulanga, Kiganga & Jongomero) in Ruaha National Park**. Hence, regarding **Award Criteria for Multiple Contracts, the Employer will aggregate minimum requirements for respective Lots/package as specified under items 3.1, 3.2, 4.2(a) and 4.2(b) of Section III (Evaluation and Qualification Criteria). However, with respect to the specific experience under item 4.2 (a) of Section III; Item (b) for Multiple Contracts; Option (i) specified in Section III of the Bidding Document will apply.** With regard to **Key Personnel and Equipment**, to be awarded multiple contracts, the bidder must present separate sets of equipment and separate teams for each lot/package. **Further details and complete qualification requirements are provided in the Bidding Documents.**

6. Bidding will be conducted through the International Competitive Bidding procedures as specified in the World Bank's *Guidelines: Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-Consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers* dated January 2011 (revised July 2014 ("Procurement Guidelines")), and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the Procurement Guidelines. In addition, please refer to paragraphs 1.6 and 1.7 setting forth the World Bank's policy on conflict of interest.

Bidders are encouraged to attend the pre-bid meeting and site visit which will be held on **9th August 2022** at 10:00 Hours at Mikumi National Park Headquarters Offices followed by Field visit at Kikoboga Airstrip in Mikumi National Park and **11th August 2022** at 10:00 hrs at Nyerere National Park Headquarters Offices followed by field visit at Kibambawe and Mtemere Airstrips in Nyerere National Park. The minutes of the pre-bid meeting will be shared with all bidders. The costs of attending the pre-bid meeting and site visit will be borne by the bidders.

8. A complete set of the bidding documents (in English) is available to interested eligible Bidders upon the submission of a written application to the address below and upon payment of a non-refundable fee of **Tanzanian Shillings One Hundred Thousand only (TZS 100,000.00) per lot** or its equivalent in freely convertible currency for each set (per bid reference number). The bidders should note that in case of any difference in the hard and the soft copy, the one in hard copy only will prevail.*

9. Bids must be delivered to The **Secretary of Tender Board, Tanzania National Parks (TANAPA), JK Nyerere Conservation Centre, P.O. Box 3134, Arusha, Tanzania.** Second Floor; Room number: 40; on or before 10:00 hrs local time on 15th September 2022. Electronic bidding will not be permitted.

Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of Bidders' designated representatives and anyone who chooses to attend at the TANAPA Board Room, 1st Floor, **JK Nyerere Conservation Centre, P.O. Box 3134, Arusha, Tanzania**, immediately after the submission deadline. Late bids will be rejected.

10. All bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security in original and in an acceptable form in the amount of TZS 230,000,000.00 (Tanzania Shillings Two Hundred Thirty Million Only) for Lot 1 and TZS 400,000,000.00 (Tanzania Shillings Four Hundred Million Only) for Lot 2 or its equivalent in any freely convertible currency.

The Bid Security shall be clearly addressed to Conservation Commissioner, **JK Nyerere Conservation Centre, P.O. Box 3134, Arusha, Tanzania.** The Bid Security shall be valid for twenty-eight (28) calendar days beyond the bid validity period, i.e.(120 days plus 28 days) , 148 calendar days after the bid's submission deadline.
