- This Invitation for Tender follows the General Procurement Notice for this project that appeared in United Nations Development Business (UNDB) Issue No. of 057061 of 17th August 2018.
- 2. The Government of the United Republic of Tanzania has received a credit from the World Bank towards the cost of the RESILIENT NATURAL RESOURCES MANAGEMENT FOR TOURISM AND GROWTH (REGROW) project and intends to apply part of the proceeds to cover eligible payments under the works contracts for Construction and Upgrading of Airstrips in Mikumi, Nyerere, and Ruaha National Parks Package B: Construction and Upgrading of three (3) Airstrips (Ulanga, Kiganga & Jongomero) in Ruaha National Park.
- 3. The Trustees of Tanzania National Parks (TANAPA) on behalf of the Ministry of Natural Resources and Tourism, hereinafter referred to as the "Employer;" now invite sealed bids from the eligible bidders for the proposed Works that shall consist of the following:
 - New 1800-meter long and 30meter wide pavement construction to comprise granular sub-base, and granular polymer-stabilized surfacing layers for Kiganga Airstrip (Code 3C)

- New 1175-meter long and 30meter wide pavement construction to comprise granular sub-base, and granular polymer-stabilized surfacing layers for Jongomero Airstrip (Code 2B)
- New 1175-meter long and 30meter wide pavement construction to comprise granular sub-base layer for Ulanga Airstrip (Code 2B)
- Newly paved taxiway and apron areas. Similar construction to the reconstructed runways.
- New surface water drainage system.
- New Terminal, RFF Buildings, and associated infrastructure works for Kiganga Airstrip which includes landside works.
- New Terminal, RFF Buildings, and associated infrastructure works for Ulanga and Jongomero Airstrips which include landside works
- Markings and Miscellaneous Works.
- New Powerhouse and Guard House for Kiganga, Ulanga, and Jongomero Airstrips
- Two underground Tanks and Water Tower for each Kiganga, Ulanga, and Jongomero Airstrips

The Contractor shall ensure proper traffic management during the construction period and comply with statutory Environment and Safety protection including Social Exploitation and Abuse (**SEA**) and Social Harassment (**SH**) guidelines.

N.B: The estimated Construction period is Fourteen (14) Months including two (2) months of mobilization.

4. Qualifications requirements for the works include experience as a prime contractor in the construction of at least one (1) contract of similar nature and complexity in the last five (5) years with a minimum value of USD 11 million or its equivalent; (ii) Average Annual Turnover calculated as total certified payments received for contracts in progress or completed, within the last five (5) years of USD 24 million or its equivalent (iii) minimum amount of liquid assets and/or credit facilities net of other contractual commitments of USD 4 million or its equivalent. Procurement of the Works under

this bid Construction and Upgrading of three (3) Airstrips (Ulanga, Kiganga & Jongomero) in Ruaha National Park is being advertised and will be executed concurrently with Package A- Lot 1: Construction and Upgrading of Kikoboga Airstrip in Mikumi National Park and Lot 2: Construction and Upgrading of Mtemere and Kibambawe Airstrips in Nyerere National Park. Hence, regarding Award Criteria for Multiple Contracts, the Employer will aggregate minimum requirements for respective Lots/packages as specified under items 3.1, 3.2, 4.2(a) and 4.2(b) of Section III (Evaluation and Qualification Criteria). However, with respect to the specific experience under item 4.2 (a) of Section III - Multiple Contracts and Option 1 shall apply. With regard to Key Personnel and Equipment, to be awarded multiple contracts, the bidder must present separate sets of equipment and separate teams for each lot/package. Further details and complete qualification requirements are provided in the Bidding Documents.

- 5. Bidding will be conducted through the International Competitive Bidding (ICB) procedures as specified in the World Bank's Guidelines: *Procurement of Goods, Works and Non-Consulting Services under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits & Grants by World Bank Borrowers; January 2011, revised July 2014* ("Procurement Guidelines"), and is open to all eligible Bidders as defined in the Procurement Guidelines. In addition, please refer to paragraphs 1.6 and 1.7 setting forth the World Bank's Policy on Conflict of Interest.

Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of Bidders' designated representatives and anyone who chooses to attend at the TANAPA Board Room, 1st Floor, **JK Nyerere** Conservation Centre, P.O. Box 3134, Arusha, Tanzania, immediately after the submission deadline. Late bids will be rejected.

All bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security in original and in an acceptable form in the amount of TZS 540,000,000.00 (Tanzania Shillings Five Hundred Forty Million Only) or its equivalent in any freely convertible currency. The Bid Security shall be clearly addressed to the Conservation Commissioner, Tanzania National Parks (TANAPA), JK Nyerere Conservation Centre, P.O. Box 3134, Arusha, Tanzania. The Bid Security shall be valid for twenty-eight (28) calendar days beyond the bid validity period of 120 days, i.e., 148 calendar days after the bid's submission deadline.
